

PIPE TRADES APPRENTICE APPLICATION FORM

QUALIFICATIONS NECESSARY FOR AN APPLICANT TO BE CONSIDERED FOR A PROBATIONARY PIPE TRADES APPRENTICESHIP

1. Must at least 18 years of age;
2. Complete both sides of application and return this form with the following;
 - a. Birth certificate or other such document for proof of age.
 - b. High school transcript. Copy of Certificate of Graduation or G.E.D. Certificate with official test scores.
3. Successfully complete aptitude test;
4. Appear for interview when notified;
5. Give a negative drug screening provided by the Local 149 JAC.

IF YOU ARE ACCEPTED FOR A PROBATIONARY APPRENTICESHIP YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO:

1. Serve as a probationary apprentice for a period of 1 year (1,700-2,000 hours of on-the-job training);
2. Serve a 5 year apprenticeship including the probationary period (8,500-10,000 hours of on-the-job training);
3. Report to work on a regular basis;
4. Provide transportation to and from work;
5. Work in Public Sector jobs without restriction;
6. Work under the direction of a Journeyman on the job site and perform job duties satisfactorily;
7. Attend related classes regularly and maintain an acceptable average in those classes;
8. Purchase test materials for use in related training classes as required;
9. Abide by all rules and regulations of the Joint Apprenticeship training Committee;
